Special round trip introductory fares are now available for new service between Mexico and Medellín, Colombia, Guayaquil, Ecuador and Lima, Peru with convenient connections to and from major U.S. markets

MEXICO CITY, April 9, 2019 Interjet Airlines announced today, it was expanding service from Mexico to several South America destinations including Medellín, Colombia, Guayaquil, Ecuador and Lima, Peru. These new flights will serve both the business and leisure traveler expanding Interjet's footprint into South America.

These special fares will be available for purchase until June 30, 2019 and valid for travel from June 5, 2019 through November 30, 2019. Promotional fares are not available to groups nor can they be used with other promotional fares.
